These efforts focus on support areas of sustainable clean water and nourishment projects, education scholarships, after school programs and vacation bible schools, financial assistance, youth sports programs, mentoring and leadership programs. 100% of your contribution towards these efforts is directly helping people develop positive and lasting life skills to help themselves and others be successful.

Over the course of the last 12 months, CTG Foundation, its founders and its donors have contributed to:

- 24 deep, sustainable clean water wells in 3rd world communities who were without a source of water prior
